A. Vogel publishes its first Sustainability Report

With its first Sustainability Report, A.Vogel transparently outlines how the company assumes ecological, social, and corporate responsibility along the entire value chain – inspired by the philosophy of Alfred Vogel.

Roggwil, 26 August 2025 – For the first time, A.Vogel AG, headquartered in Roggwil TG, is publishing a comprehensive Sustainability Report. The report follows the standards of the Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) with reference to their framework and documents the key developments and figures relating to sustainability for the year 2024.

The report highlights key topics such as health and product safety, ecological farming, biodiversity, CO₂ accounting, and a responsible supply chain. Numerous initiatives and indicators illustrate how A.Vogel reduces its environmental impact and consistently implements sustainable business practices.

"Sustainability at A.Vogel is not a trend – it has been part of our identity for over 100 years," says Bukurim Selmani, Compliance Officer and Sustainability Manager. "With this report, we demonstrate how deeply responsibility is embedded in all our decisions – from cultivation and production to packaging and our employees."

Practical examples include the use of rainwater for irrigation, the fact that 95% of all plant-based raw materials are sourced from organic cultivation, and the recycling of ethanol, which saved around 242 tonnes of CO₂ in 2024.

"'We should learn to live with nature and protect it' – this guiding principle of Alfred Vogel has always shaped our corporate culture," adds Andy Suter, CEO of A.Vogel AG. "The Sustainability Report shows how we put this principle into practice every day."

Selected highlights from the report:

- 152 tonnes of CO₂ saved annually through organic cultivation
- 95% of plant-based raw materials from organic sources
- 100% recycling of ethanol and plant waste
- 72% employee satisfaction in the latest staff survey
